The City of Belfast Crematorium based at Roselawn offers cremation services for the whole of Northern Ireland. Their cremation fees include the disposal of cremated remains packed for collection, scattered, or buried in the Garden of Remembrance. They also include a cremation certificate.

If the deceased is a life member of the Cremation Society of Great Britain, or the Cremation Assurance Friendly Society, the fee will be recovered from the society. The following tables outline the cost for cremation dependent on residency within the City of Belfast Council Area:
